ESCH

LOWER SCHOOL

ESD+ lower school programs are faculty-led, interest-based activities that meet on campus weekly both before and after school. Past programs include book 'n cook, Latin dance, chess, French, engineering, handbells, math olympiads, singers, strings, and various arts and sports.

Kids on Campus (KOC) extended day provides after-school care, staffed by faculty, where students participate in creative games and activities, enjoy outside free play, and have the opportunity to complete homework with teacher support.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

ESD+ middle school programs are teacher-led, interest-based activities that meet on campus weekly both before and after school. Past programs include book club, chess, clay guild, community service council, fishing, French, honors choir, knitting, pickle ball, youth and government, and more.

ESD+ extended day provides a monitored time and space, before and after school, for middle school students to engage in a variety of activities such as working on homework with classmates, playing games, meeting with teachers and most importantly, getting to know their class and form bonds that foster inclusivity.
